

# UNIFORM POLICY 2010/2011

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

## BOYS:

- **Pants:** Navy blue dress slacks (plain) with a solid navy, black, or brown leather belt.
- **Shirts:**
  - Kindergarten-Grade 4:** Light blue polo shirt (short or long sleeves, Saint Mary's logo or plain).
  - Grades 5-8:** Light blue oxford shirt button-down (short or long sleeves, Saint Mary's logo or plain).

## GIRLS:

- **Jumper:** Rose uniform number 7253. **Grades Kindergarten-4.**
- **Plaid skirt:** Rose uniform number 3453. **Grades 5-8.**  
(Skirt length no shorter than 2" above the *middle of the knee in the front and back*, and shorts must be worn under skirts/jumpers every day.)
- **Blouses:**
  - Kindergarten-4:** White rounded collar blouse-plain (short or long sleeves).
  - Grades 5-8:** Light blue oxford button-down blouse (short or long sleeves, Saint Mary's logo or plain)
- **Pants:** Navy dress pants are optional from November 1 through March 31 and must be worn with solid navy, black, or brown belts.

## ALL STUDENTS:

- **Shoes:** PK-3/PK4 tennis shoes. K-3 oxford style lace-ups or buckles. 4-8 oxford style lace-ups only. Navy, black, or brown leather or saddle oxfords are acceptable. No patent leather. **No slip-ons (including ballet, deck shoes/Sperry's, etc.) No sling-backs, open toes, or boots of any kind (including ankle boots) are allowed.** For *safety reasons*, shoes must completely cover toes and heels. Girls' shoes must have a heel **no higher than 1"**.
- **Socks:** Girls must wear plain white or navy knee socks or tights. Boys must wear plain white or navy crew socks. **No sport socks or anklets.**
- **Sweaters:** Saint Mary's sweatshirt from Rose Uniform Company #662. Navy or red cardigan—plain or with St. Mary's logo #6300.
- **Jewelry:** 1 simple ring.  
1 simple chain with religious medal or cross.  
Girls may wear a single pair of **post** earrings in the earlobes. **Boys may not wear earrings.** No other piercings allowed.
- **Hair:** No dye or hair coloring/highlighting of any kind. No unusual styles. Boys' hair must be above the eyebrow, above the top of the ear, and above the collar.

## SUMMER UNIFORM OPTION:

To be worn:

- Any day from the first day of school to September 20.
- May 1 through the last day of school.
- **Shorts:** Navy. Rose Uniforms style only, #108 (girls) or #118 (boys).
- **Shirts:** Light blue polo shirt, plain or with Saint Mary's logo. No oxford shirts or blouses. (Please note: this shirt is not to be worn with skirts/jumpers.)

## P.E. DAYS:

- Athletic shoes are required for P.E. Students in grades K-3 may wear athletic shoes to school on P.E. days. Students in grades 4-8 need to bring their athletic shoes to school on P.E. days to change into.

## OUT-OF-UNIFORM DAYS:

The spirit of the school dress code applies to out-of-uniform days. General regulations and jewelry regulations apply. The following may **not** be worn:

- Clothing printed with inappropriate advertisements.
- Midriff-baring shirts/spaghetti straps/tank tops.
- Sweatpants.
- Sagging pants or pants without belts.
- Torn, ripped, ragged, or tight-fitting jeans or pants.
- Make-up/nail polish.
- Spandex.
- Short shorts or mini skirts.
